Anti-Ragging Instructions

The students should note that **Ragging is banned** by a ruling of the Hon'ble. Supreme Court of India. The Institute has made adequate arrangements to ensure that no incidence of ragging takes place. Faculty members have been appointed on duty in various Buildings and Floors, Canteens, outside the Main Gate of the Institute etc. to ensure the same. They will be on duty at least up to the conduct of Fresher Parties that should happen during the last week of August 2009.

The students must not indulge in any such activity that could even be remotely associated with or termed as ragging by any fresher.

According to the Hon'ble. Supreme Court of India *ragging includes "disorderly behaviour/treatment with fellow student whether by words, spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating and handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or indecent activities, which may cause or likely to cause physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student"*.

Some of the punishments for students directly or indirectly involved in ragging and its abetment are as follows:

- Cancellation of Admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Suspension/Expulsion from the hostel.
- Expulsion from the Institution.
- Fine up to Rs. 2,50,000/-
- Lodging FIR/Police Action against an offender.
- Rigorous Imprisonment up to 3 years (under the Court of Law).

As a measure of preventing ragging we have sent letters to the parents of our senior students so that they can counsel their wards for not indulging in ragging of any type. The parents of our senior students are also required to sign the undertaking that they know about the above rulings and the punishments for those who happen to indulge in ragging and that their wards will not indulge in ragging. Similarly, the students are required to give an undertaking that they know the above rulings and punishment for those who happen to indulge in ragging and that they will not indulge in ragging. The formats of the letter to the parents and undertakings are given below.

The Institute makes adequate arrangements to avoid incidence of ragging in and around the campus. You are also requested to counsel your ward and see that he/she does not indulge directly or indirectly in ragging in any form.

The enclosed Undertakings are required to be completed and signed by you and your ward on Rs.10 non-judicial stamp papers, and deposited with the Registrar, IMS, Dehradun by 25 July 2009. Your support in maintaining **"Ragging Free Campus"** will go a long way in enhancing the image of IMS, Dehradun.
